Did you know...Mexican jumping beans are seed pods that contain the larvae of a small moth (Cydia saltitans)? These beans, which are not actually beans, but seed pods of the shrub Sebastiania pavoniana, are native to Mexico. The larva inside the seed pod causes the pod to move, or "jump", due to its movements, particularly when warmed.
